

When Arie and I joined the Beit Tovei Ha'Ir family nearly four years ago we came *directly* from our home in London, England, together with our daughter and her husband who had made all the arrangements for us. So, unlike most of the residents here, we had not been **living** in Eretz Yisrael beforehand although we had enjoyed many holiday visits over the years.

Naturally, there were a great deal of adjustments to make, one of which was LANGUAGE; no – I don't mean learning lvrit [which is an ongoing process!]: most of the residents – many of whom do speak English – if not real Israelis, are from U.S.A. or Canada, and they do speak English but have a somewhat different vocabulary. Here are a few examples:
